

DEVELOPING STORY: NIGERIA POLICE RECEIVING DOZENS OF FORD F550 PITBULL VX MINE-PROTECTED APCs FOR CTCOIN OPERATIONS..70 FRESHLY DELIVERED UNITS SPOTTED AT A PARKING LOT IN S.W NIGERIA

Reports made available to Beegeagle's Blog through very reliable back channel communication indicate that, following swiftly on the heels of last April's acquisition of fourteen units of the impressive Ford F550 Pitbull VX APCs by the Ogun State Government for onward delivery to the State Police Command as tokens of operational support, the High Command of the Nigeria Police Force which has quietly been taking delivery of and deploying the APCs, have now splashed out consequentially on a major haul of the awesome Ford F550 Pitbull VX.

Our source who was unable to give an exact figure of the total haul of Pitbull APCs in view, however stated that they accurately "counted about 70 spanking new machines parked somewhere in Ogun State (sorry, their location is highly classified).
